The Basics of Our Plan

Quail Summit Elementary School is focused each month on a different character trait (responsibility, courage, citizenship, respect, tolerance, compassion, honesty, cooperation, perseverance and fairness.)

Each month character heroes are focused on who exemplify the character trait of the month.

Teachers provide lessons in the classroom to reinforce the character trait and hero of the month.

Children's literature is used to emphasize core ethical values.

The "Student of the Month" awards are presented to those who exemplify and work toward the character trait of the month.

Character coupons are given out to reinforce ethical behavior in students

A character crew comprised of students, teachers and parents promotes service to others as well as instilling core attributes.

Student Council works in conjunction with our character education program thematically tying in service to the attribute of the month and involving the entire school in the process.

Character traits are displayed on bulletin boards in a main hallway to reinforce concepts.

The entire staff is involved in integrating values into the culture of the classroom and the school.
